

2017–2018 Selective Service

The Selective Service could not confirm your registration. Men ages 18-25 are required to register with the Selective Service System to be eligible to receive federal financial aid. Please check one box below:

- **You must** go online and register: www.sss.gov. Once your registration is confirmed, print out the official letter of verification to document your Selective Service registration and submit it to the financial aid office.
- I am 26 years or older and have never registered for the Selective Service.
- **You must** complete and mail a “Request for Status Information Letter” to the Selective Service: www.sss.gov. Once you receive the response letter from Selective Service, you must bring in a copy to the financial aid office.
 - **You must** provide a detailed statement giving the reason(s) you did not register between the ages of 18-25.

Submit both the Selective Service response letter and your written statement to the financial aid office.

- If you were born before 1960, you are exempt. Notify the financial aid office of your status.
- I am a female and not required to register with Selective Service.
