The TVCC Testing Center in Ontario is committed to providing services through finals week as deemed necessary for final exam requirements.

The testing center occupancy is no more than 30 at full capacity with a combination of 18 computer stations and 12 paper stations. The stations are predominately offset (i.e. computers station and paper station every other chair).

The Ontario TVCC Testing Center still do computer/canvas testing in the current testing center location and schedule PAC 107 to administer paper test overflows to comply with social distancing. We are committed to staffing as needed to accommodate this set up Monday through Wednesday. Students will still need to check in with the main testing center desk and will be escorted to the appropriate location for testing. If a bottleneck occurs for testing check-in, staff will monitor the line to make sure that no more than 4-5 individuals waiting to check-in, if we exceed that limit we will ask students wait outside until called upon. The Ontario TVCC Testing Center will continue normal operating hours which can be found here:
